

## OIA-ILH Football Proposal

### I. Alliance

- A. The OIA and ILH form a combined league for varsity and junior varsity level football only
- B. Three year pilot project to be reviewed annually by both leagues

### II. Varsity Level

- A. Three varsity divisions of competition – Open Division, Division I and Division II
  1. Open Division (10 teams – 9 Games)
    - a. OIA – 7 teams (Determined by OIA)
    - b. ILH – 3 teams (Kamehameha-Kapalama, Punahou, and Saint Louis)
    - c. If BIIF and/or MIL participate, schedule format will be adjusted
  2. Division I (10 teams – 9 Games)
    - a. OIA – 8 teams (Determined by OIA)
    - b. ILH – 2 teams (Damien and Iolani)
  3. Division II (9 teams – 8 Games)
    - a. OIA – 7 teams (Determined by OIA)
    - b. ILH – 2 teams (PAC-5 and Saint Francis)
- B. HHSAA Football Championships
  1. Open Division
    - a. Top 6 teams qualify (OIA-ILH – 6)
    - b. If BIIF and MIL choose to participate – top 8 teams qualify
    - c. If either BIIF or MIL choose to participate – top 6 teams will qualify
  2. Division I: 6 teams per HHSAA formula (OIA -3; ILH- 1; BIIF- 1; MIL- 1)
  3. Division II: 6 teams per HHSAA formula (OIA- 2; ILH- 1; BIIF- 1; MIL- 1; KIF- 1)

### III. Junior Varsity Level

- A. One junior varsity division of competition
  1. Division I (10 teams)
    - a. OIA – 7 teams (Determined by OIA)
    - b. ILH – 3 teams (Kamehameha-Kapalama, Punahou, Saint Louis)

### IV. Additional ILH & HHSAA Eligibility Rule Changes – Football Only

- A. Minimum 2.0 GPA
- B. Junior Varsity Football – No 11th graders (juniors) eligible to play JV football
- C. Oahu public to ILH school transfers – sit out two years
- D. Neighbor island (public or private) to ILH school transfers – sit out two years
